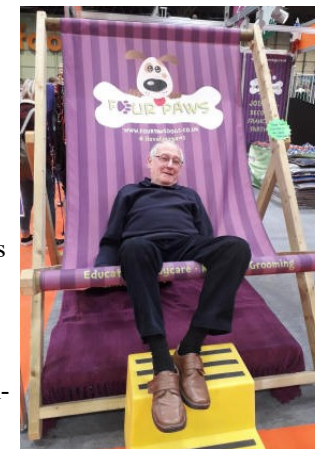

Numerous other manufacturers may use questionable ingredients and dubious practices. Hills has had to recall batches of food in March, that could put dogs at serious risk of vitamin D poisoning. FENCE ERECTED AT FELPHAM

A fence has been put up by Arun Council along the boundary of the Greensward in Felpham to help manage the issue of dog fouling in this area. An Arun spokesman said that Dog fouling along the green has been an ongoing problem and has frequently generated complaints from beach hut users and the public. Access to the grass remains unrestricted via the gates on the western and eastern end of the green, and dogs are not banned from the area. Karl Roberts, Director of Place at Arun District Council said: "As the fence is too high for dogs to jump over, it is hoped less fouling will occur as it is suspected that this happens when dogs are being walked off the lead either late in the evening, or early in the morning."

A more cynical view is that the Fence has been erected to keep the Beach hut owners and their children in rather than keeping Dogs out !

SUMMER HAZARDS: There are numerous hazards which can be found the most obvious being the various pesticides and weed killers, in particular **slug pellets**, many often claim to be pet friendly but it is better to be on the safe side and keep them away from your dogs completely. Dogs are very partial to **Mulch** which is often made from Cocoa shells, which contain *Theobromine* which can make dogs very ill – or even worse. Apart from possible harmful flowers and plants in the garden, care should also be taken in Parks and public places where **weed killer and pesticide** is often used indiscriminately.
